

COLLEGE DRESS CODE

27 September 2023

1. Uniform

- a. Approved colour – Khaki Cloth
- b. Proper fitting; no alteration in trouser specially reducing the size of bottom.
- c. **Shoes**. Oxford pattern black shoes with laces and toe.

2. Shalwar Qamees

- a. White wash – n – wear cloth.
- b. Shirt with collars and cuffs. No band and no embroidery.
- c. No Pajama, instead proper shalwar.
- d. Colour of buttons white / transparent.
- e. Shalwar and Qamees should not be with tight fitting.
- f. Peshawari Chappal (single black colour)

3. Walking Out Dress

- a. White shirt (wash – n – wear cloth) with collar and cuff, When the whiteness fades out significantly, it should be replaced with a new one.
- b. Grey trousers.
- c. No alteration to convert into tight fitting or awkward length of trousers

4. **Sports Dress**. As provided by College. It should be worn only during sports / PT periods. PT shoes shall be of white colour.

5. **Socks**. Socks should be of full size. Black colour with uniform and walking out dress, white colour with PT dress and House colour with sports dress.

Note 1: Picture of all above dresses and footwear shall be displayed on Notice Board for strict compliance.

Note 2: This dress code should be implemented with immediate effect. However, if some items need to be purchased, it should be done as soon as possible. The dress code will be fully effective from 06 November 2023 after which action will be taken against the defaulters.
